END OF TERM EVENTS 2022

Below are details about the end of term events that are happening at school – there may be a couple more to add (some of the Year 6 events are missing!), but this is what we know for sure. Most of the dates were given at the beginning of the year but not the timings or details.

New Entrants Teddy Bears' Picnic – Tuesday 21st June 2022 – 2pm

New reception parents and their children meet to get to know each other. Details are on the invitation.

Sports Day – Thursday 23rd June 2022 – 1-3pm (approximately)

The children will be doing some team activities in the morning in their classes. After lunch will be track and field events which parents are welcome to come and watch. You will need to bring your own chair or blanket. Siblings and other family members are also welcome.

Children should come to school in their PE kit (navy shorts/skort and yellow t-shirt with trainers. They will need suncream applied and to bring in their hat and water bottle.

There will be ice creams and Iollies for sale by the Year 6 team at the END of the event.

New entrants' taster afternoons – 30th June and 7th July

Transition afternoon for all children – 7th July

Children will spend the afternoon in their new classrooms with their new teacher. You will receive a letter with information about the class and a link to a form which enables you to share information about your child with their new teacher.

Open Classroom/Meet the teacher – 13th July 3:15 – 4:30pm

Children's books are not all coming home at the end of term as we are passing them up to the next class to help with progression and transition but also to reduce the waste created by starting a new book in every subject each year. Because of this you are invited into your child's classroom to look at their work. The timings for this are 3:15 – 4:00pm.

Between 4:00 – 4:30pm, your child's new teacher will be in their classroom for you to pop in and say hello and see their room if you wish.
