How our clubs are organised

How to join a club

Parents can sign up for clubs on the school cloud website which is the same site used to book for parents evening <https://wateringbury.schoolcloud.co.uk>. If your child was already booked in to a club before half term they still have their place and you have no need to book again. If you no longer want a place for a club, please let the office know and they will cancel your place so another child can have the space. If you wish to join a club once term has started, and if there are still spaces, please email the office to let them know you have signed up so they can let the club leader know (we don't check this website all the time!).

Consent for the club and pick up information are given on the website at the time of booking. If the club is full, please email the office to ask to be put on a waiting list if a space becomes available.

Some clubs will only run if a minimum number of members join.

How to pay for clubs

Payment for all clubs is now required. Most externally run clubs (apart from gymnastics) are £3.50 per session. Unfortunately, if payment isn't received in then the pupil will not be able to attend the external club. The cost for school run clubs, which includes approximately 10 weeks, is £5. However, you can book as many clubs as you want for the same period for £10. Note this does NOT include external clubs, these will incur an additional payment as detailed above.

Please make payment online via the school gateway or by cash or cheque, payable to Wateringbury Primary School. Payment MUST be made at the beginning of term and preferably by the end of the first week. Please note we have a small fund to assist with the payment of clubs. Please contact the office if you wish to request support with payments. We are an inclusive organisation and do not money to be a barrier to children accessing clubs.

Netball Club

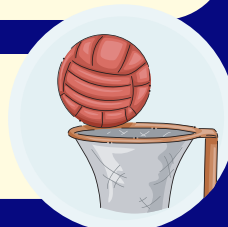


Tuesday lunchtime 12:15 - 1:00pm

Gardening

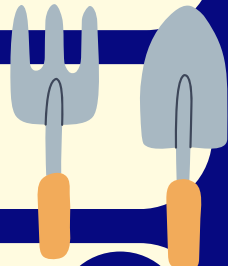


Wednesday after school 3:15 - 4:15pm

Chess

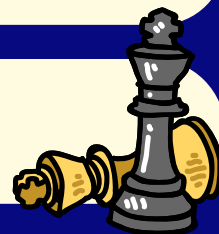


Thursday after school 3:15 - 4:15pm

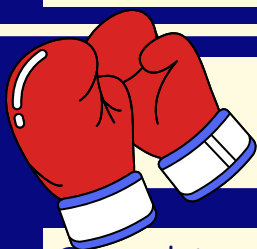
