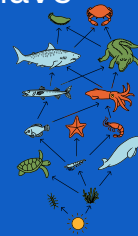

Fundamentals - Developing the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping.

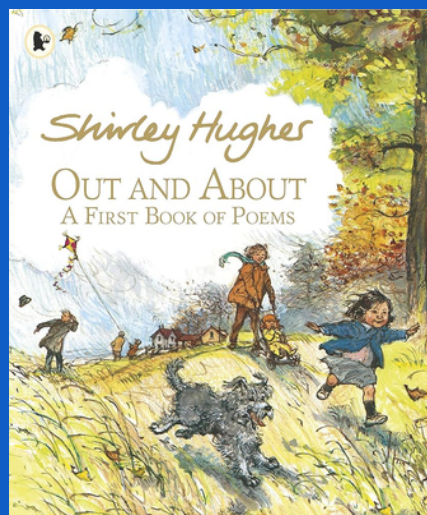


Target Games - Develop skills to send an object to a target with control and accuracy.

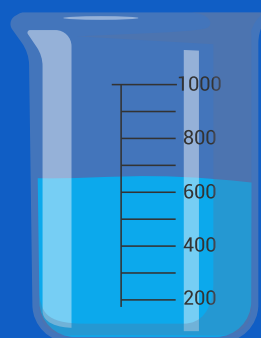
