How our clubs are organised

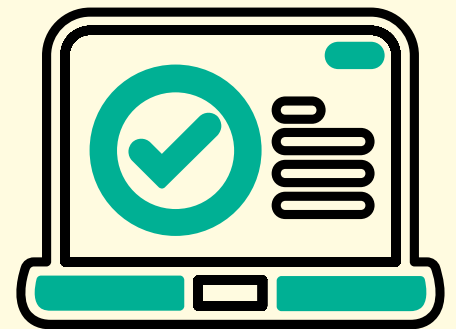
How to join a club

Parents can sign up for clubs using the school gateway app (where you pay for trips, etc.) If you wish to join a club once term has started, and if there are still spaces, please email the office to let them know you have signed up so they can let the club leader know (we don't check the app all the time!). Consent for the club and pick up information are given at the time of booking.

If you have managed to book a place then you are in.

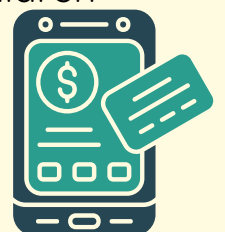
Some clubs will only run if a minimum number of members join.

We will try to ensure that the activity club is available each term. We try to ensure that places booked in the autumn are guaranteed for the rest of the year (although you do need to sign up again). This should make it easier to arrange childcare and other family arrangements.



How to pay for clubs

Payment for all clubs is now required. Football club (externally run) is £5 per session. Unfortunately, if payment isn't received then the pupil will not be able to attend the external club. The cost for school run clubs, which includes approximately 10 weeks, is £10. However, you can book as many clubs as you want for the same period for £20 (just don't submit payment for the third and fourth clubs). Note this does NOT include external clubs, these will incur an additional payment as detailed above. Please make payment online via the school gateway. Payment MUST be made at the beginning of term and preferably by the end of the second week. Please note we have a small fund to assist with the payment of clubs. Please contact the office if you wish to request support with payments. We are an inclusive organisation and do not want cost to be a barrier to children accessing clubs.

Gardening

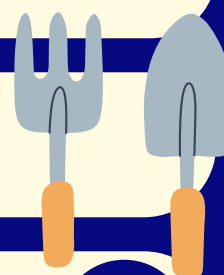


Wednesday after school 3:15 - 4:30pm

A relaxed fun choir for the younger children in school. A chance to sing some popular songs with friends.



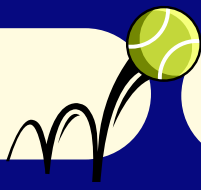
